Andy Oppenheimer AExpE MIABTI is a UK-based analyst, author and lecturer in CBRNE (chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear weapons and explosives) and counterterrorism. He is Editor of Chemical, Biological & Nuclear Warfare (CBNW) and former Editor of Jane's Nuclear, Biological and Chemical Defence. He is an Associate Member of the Institute of Explosives Engineers and a Member of the International Association of Bomb Technicians and Investigators. His book *IRA: The Bombs and the Bullets - A History of Deadly Ingenuity* (Irish Academic Press, 2008) is acknowledged as the definitive title on the military campaign of the Irish republican movement and is used in EOD (explosives ordnance disposal) training in the US and UK. He is also author of the CBRN Module for the world-renowned Terrorism Studies course conducted by the University of St Andrews, and is writing the Counter-IED Module for the same course in 2013.
