On behalf of the Republic and canton of Geneva, it is a privilege to invite you to the CBRN Conference in Geneva on the 11th and 12th of November 2019.

This year's summit is timed to coincide with the Franco-Swiss joint security exercise taking place at the Geneva Stadium on the 13th of November. A simulated CBRN incident happening in the city will provide you the opportunity to witness first-hand, interventions by our specialized civil and military response units. These men and women will

be working hand-in-hand with their French counterparts who are our neighbors and most valued partners in this exercise.


